MINNEAPOLIS RADIATION ONCOLOGY

FROM THE EAST

Take I-494 West, merge onto I-35E South.
Exit on Cliff Rd, turn right and continue to Hwy 13 (toward Burnsville).
Follow Hwy 13 West.
Continue West/Southwest as Hwy 13 joins with Hwy 101 and with Hwy 169 South.
Continue on Hwy 169 South Exit on Marschall Rd/Hwy 17.
Turn left onto Marschall Rd.
Turn left on Valley View Rd, Hospital Main Entrance will be on your left.

FROM THE WEST

Take I-94 East, merge onto I-494 South.
Take I-494 South to Hwy 5.
Take Hwy 5 West, merge onto Hwy 41 (in Chanhassen), turn right to travel South.
Continue South on Hwy 41 to Hwy 169.
Turn left onto Hwy 169.
Continue on Hwy 169 Exit on Marschall Rd/Hwy 17.
Turn right onto Marschall Rd.
Turn left on Valley View Rd, Hospital Main Entrance will be on your left.

FROM THE NORTH

Take I-494 South, merge onto Hwy 169 South.
Continue on Hwy 169 exit onto Marschall Rd/Hwy 17.
Turn left onto Marschall Rd.
Turn left on Valley View Rd, Hospital Main Entrance will be on your left.

FROM THE SOUTH

Take Hwy 169 North, Exit onto Marschall Rd/Hwy 17.
Turn right onto Marschall Rd.
Turn left on Valley View Rd, Hospital Main Entrance will be on your left.
